GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN THE MANAGEMENT OF ELDER ABUSE

(Single semester programme)

15 ECTS at academic level 9

This is a new multi-disciplinary programme focusing on the management of elder abuse. The programme aims to develop and enhance competencies related to the domain of elder abuse management. The programme is open to professionals who work in health or social care services related to older people.

All aspects of elder abuse practice and research will be covered, including legislation, policy, prevention, detection, reporting, investigating, caring for victims and perpetrators. The programme will also cover contextual issues related to elder abuse such as ageism, mental capacity, the sociology of ageing, etc.

The programme allows the flexibility of studying from home with 3 days in University College Dublin (may be weekdays/Saturdays).
