

Respect for Seniors Campaign

St Ives Uniting Church launched the Respect for Seniors campaign last year to encourage respectful attitudes toward older people in our community.

The campaign is based on three key concepts:

- Research has identified ageism and lack of respect as major factors in the mistreatment of older adults. Older adults nominate respect as a key contributor to their quality of life.
- A respectful society creates a sense of safety and being valued
- Community engagement is a powerful process for helping to change attitudes and behaviours.

On 14 June 2009, St Ives Uniting Church organised a Purple Ribbon 'celebration of ageing' service to acknowledge World Elder Abuse Awareness Day.

People were invited to wear a purple ribbon or item of clothing . The response was so successful the event was renamed 'Wear Purple Day'.
