*Trauma through the Life Cycle from a Strengths Perspective:
An International Dialogue*

January 8th and 9th 2012

An International conference to be held at the Hebrew University, Jerusalem, Israel, sponsored by The Paul Baerwald School of Social Work and Social Welfare and New York University Silver School of Social Work.

The goals of the conference:

1. To recognize and strengthen the empirical knowledge and international dialogue on the differential impact of trauma throughout the life cycle - from early childhood to old age.
2. To understand the differential effects of trauma and recovery in relation to gender, culture, type of events, and personal and communal history
3. To explore the role of and practice guidelines for Social Workers and other helping professionals in various traumatic situations.
4. To connect researchers and clinicians interested in collaborating on topics related to this conference.

You are invited to submit papers with empirical, theoretical and practical significance. Presentations can take the forms of: Individual Papers, Workshops or Panel

The abstract should not exceed 500 words, Times New Roman, size 12, single space.

It should include: a cover page with title of the presentation, type of presentation (paper, panel or workshop), names, institutional affiliations and full contact information of all presenters (address and e-mails) and roles of each presenter.

Abstract parts to include:

- The aims of the presentation and its significance
- Methodology/process of the intervention or project
- Findings and Implications, if paper is empirical
